


68 Years of ACTION

Our Impact



We serve upwards of 10,000 people each year.

We pride ourselves on helping our clients achieve more self-sufficient lives. Our programs focus on vulnerable populations that are often underserved by traditional services, including senior citizens, veterans, individuals with physical and intellectual disabilities, and youths who have aged out of foster care.

Whether it be helping to find an affordable place to live, preventing foreclosure on a home, performing weatherization work for low-income households, or simply checking in with a client to see how they are doing, people are the most important part of our work.





We provide **2,000 units** of affordable housing

We provide over 2,000 units of affordable housing and own 43 properties and counting. Building on our success, we are on track to develop an additional 361 units of housing with a total development cost of \$128 million by 2028.

The recently completed project, Flats on Forward, has revitalized a vacant corridor, activating a vital intersection in Squirrel Hill. This \$25 million development includes affordable housing and commercial space, ensuring economic diversity and enhancing the neighborhood with new real estate.




